The Utilization of RESCUE Funds

Background

Subdivision 10 of section 3641 of the Education Law provides for the apportionment of State Aid for Rebuilding Schools to Uphold Education (RESCUE). This program was intended to provide additional support for critical school building projects. Eligible projects for RESCUE Aid include projects for the design, planning, construction, acquisition, reconstruction, rehabilitation or improvement of a public school building used primarily for instruction that is

- an accessibility project,
- an educational technology project,
- a health and safety project,
- a physical capacity expansion project, and or
- a construction emergency project.

In addition, the project must have been approved by the voters of the school district or, for school districts where voter approval is not required, approved by the trustees or board of education on or after July 1, 1998 or before July 1, 2003. Any school district receiving RESCUE aid must also provide an assurance to the Commissioner that all projects funded under this subdivision will be maintained in good repair.

Funds in support of this program were provided for in two multi-year appropriations. \$145 million was appropriated in support of the program in the 1999-2000 State Budget and an additional \$50 million was provided for in 2000-01. Statutory language to establish the maximum amount to be made available to each district for eligible projects was also established at the time of appropriation (subparagraphs 11 and 11-a of paragraph a of subdivision 10 of section 3641 of the Education Law).

In order to receive funds for expenditures made in the 1999-2000 through 2002-03 school years, school districts must make application to the State Education Department and the applications must be approved by July 1, 2003. Funding for 2003-04 expenditures must be applied for by August 1, 2003, and must be approved by the State Education Department by October 1, 2003. Any remaining funds that are uncommitted as of November 1, 2003 will be distributed to districts on a competitive basis, with priority given to districts with outstanding needs as defined by the district's five year facility plan. In addition, Chapter 72 of the Laws of 2002 provided that the Roosevelt Union Free School District would be given first priority in the award of such funds, due to the combination of its financially distressed condition and the structural deficiencies of certain facilities that have been identified by state authorities and a structural engineer retained by the district, the subsequent closure of such facilities by the Commissioner, and the need identified by the Commissioner for immediate action to ensure the health, safety and educational welfare of the occupants of such facilities.

Subparagraph 2 of paragraph c of subdivision 10 of section 3641 of the Education Law also requires the Commissioner to report to the Governor and the Legislature by February 1, 2003 as to the amount of any maximum additional apportionment available to each school

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district, whether in total or in part, that has not been applied for by any such school district by January 1, 2003. This report is in fulfillment of that requirement.

Summary of Findings:

Two appropriations have been made in support of RESCUE grants; \$145 million that was appropriated in the 1999-2000 State Budget and a \$50 million appropriation that was enacted as part of the 2000-01 State Budget.

Overall, as of January 1, 2003 school districts had applied for a total of \$127.1 million, or 65% of the \$195.0 million that has been appropriated for this purpose. Of the \$127.1 million that has been allocated, districts have already received \$119.3 million, or 94% of the allocated funds. The remaining \$7.8 million is comprised of claims that have been submitted to and approved by the Department but that have not yet been paid. The remaining \$67.9 million is unallocated and remains available until October 1, 2003.

To date, 282 of the 680 eligible districts have claimed their full allocation, for a total of \$42.6 million. Another 163 districts have submitted claims for a portion of their allocation. These claims total \$84.5 million, while an additional \$34.6 million remains unclaimed by these districts. The remaining 235 districts have not been apportioned any RESCUE funding, although they are eligible for up to \$33.3 million. Table 1, below, presents the number of districts in each need resource category and their status relative to their RESCUE allocation.

On the basis of this information, Rural High Need and Average Need Districts have been the most active in fully utilizing the funding available to them, followed by Urban-Suburban High Need and Low Need Districts. Only one of the Big Five districts has fully used its available RESCUE apportionment. On the other hand, all of the Big Five have utilized their apportionments to some extent, whereas between 30% and 41% of the districts in each of the other categories have not yet received approval for RESCUE funding.

For a more complete comparison, Table 2 (below) presents data on the dollar amount of RESCUE that has been applied for and awarded to districts.

On the basis of this comparison, New York City, which has drawn down 75% of the available funding, is the most successful at utilizing RESCUE funds, followed by the Big Four at 64%. The remaining four need-resource categories are grouped fairly closely together, having used between 57% and 62% of the available funding. As shown in Table 1, however, 281 districts in those four categories have fully used the funds available to them.

It should be noted that, although nearly \$68 million remains unallocated at the time of this report, districts still may submit claims for all eligible expenditures through the end of the 2002-03 school year, and may claim aid for 2003-04 expenditures until August 1, 2003. Although it is not possible to predict what the district response will be over that time period, it is likely that districts will attempt to maximize their State revenues to combat fiscal stresses, and the actual amount that will be available for reallocation as of November 1, 2003 will be significantly less than \$68 million.

District Tabulation

The remainder of this report consists of a district-by-district tabulation for each of the RESCUE appropriations. Each table displays the following information for each district;

- Allocation – the amount for which the district is eligible to apply;
- Paid to Date – the amount which the district has claimed and which has been paid to date;
- Unpaid Claims – the amount which the district has claimed where the claims have been approved and have not yet been paid; and
- Unallocated Funds – the amount remaining for which districts are eligible to apply.
