GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS: Only those school districts wishing to accrue the apportionment provided pursuant to Chapter 56 of the Laws of 2022 as revenue to the 2022-23 school year, and thereby reduce revenues in the 2023-24 school year by an equal amount, should complete and submit this form. No apportionment may be claimed on this form in excess of the additional accruals required to be made by school districts in the 2004-05 and 2005-06 school years associated with changes for such public pension liabilities, as well as any additional costs associated with such public pension liabilities. An original copy of the required <u>Board Resolution</u> approved by the president of the board of education or the trustees and one (1) completed copy of the form should be filed by the district with the State Aid Unit not later than June 30, 2023. If approved, the claimed apportionment will be paid in September 2023.
