No apportionment may be claimed on this form in excess of the additional accruals required to be made by school districts in the 2004-05 and 2005-06 school years associated with changes for such public pension liabilities, as well as any additional costs associated with such public pension liabilities. An original copy of the required Board Resolution approved by the president of the board of education or the trustees and one (1) completed copy of the form should be filed by the district with the State Aid Unit to later than June 30, 2018. This application will be accepted based on date of postmark. If approved, the claimed apportionment will be paid in September 2018.
